BUSINESS

- **Finances:** Friends of Wenonah Trails has \$5,461.
- **Chairman's Report:** There was a Synnott's Pond meeting with Chuck, Bob, and Matt Bush last week. Paperwork for State permits is in process. A critical deed covering the bulk of the pond is missing; Chuck and others are trying to locate it.

12 more tons of stone need to be placed in gabion baskets at the Synnott dam. The stone placement should be done at the scheduled November 5th work party.

- **Trail Maintenance (Frank Eggert):** Missing bridge planks on Eldridge Trail bridges have been replaced, plus some. The work party to improve drainage on South Marion Avenue was successful. Trees have been reported down at Comey's Lake (near Academy Hills) and at Wenonah Lake.

Conservation signs are partly done, but the sign shop admitted the paint colors were not correct. Frank presented several alternatives and solicited feedback.

Chuck reports that Stewart Estate plaques for the Mullens property and Comey's Lake are ready for installation. We must choose locations and install them. Bob says he has at least some of the required concrete forms.
